


Upon examination of the statute under which you were convicted, this office concludes that these convictions do not, in whole or part, constitute a crime involving moral turpitude. As such, these convictions do not have an effect on admissibility to the United States under Section 212(a)(2)(A)(i)(1) of the INA.

It is the determination of this office that you are eligible for travel to the United States. Your inspection, upon applying for admission to the United States, will be conducted in the normal process accorded an applicant seeking admission into this country. To help facilitate future travel, it is recommended that you carry this letter for presentation to the inspecting officer.
